## 50<sup>th</sup> Annual Ahwatukee Spring Festival and Craft Fair

**Date** Saturday, April 4, 2026, 11 am - 4 pm

**Vendor – Food Truck Space** Booth spaces are available for rent at the Spring Festival. Spring Festival is an outdoor party for the entire family at the Ahwatukee Community Park. Over 5,000 residents enjoy live entertainment, vendor booths & food trucks after the Easter Parade and until 4:00 pm. Children especially like the bouncy houses & egg hunt. Admission to the Spring Festival is free to the public.

**Media** The Ahwatukee Kiwanis Club will publicize the event in the *Ahwatukee Foothills News*, the *Arizona Republic*, on social media, neighborhood action sites, in an email campaign, with community flyers, and on <https://www.ahwatukeeeasterparade.com>

**Space Location** Artists, crafters, merchants, food stands or food trucks, and service providers commonly rent space. The corners of the booth spaces are chalked on the grass. Each space measures about 11' x 11'. **Event sponsors** will have their names placed on a reserved space for their booth and banner in a preferred location. Those who are not sponsors may choose an unassigned booth space on a first come, first served basis. For safety and ground upkeep, **please do not drive on the grass.**

### Eligibility & Payment

The Kiwanis Club of Ahwatukee determines the eligibility of each vendor. The vendor fee is included for sponsors, \$85.00 for businesses and food vendors, and \$60 for nonprofits. Payment is due Thursday, April 10, 2025. Your spot as a vendor is confirmed only when we receive and review your application and receive your fee. Once the Ahwatukee Kiwanis Club approves your application, your rental fee is NON-REFUNDABLE.

**Water and Soft Drink Sales Restriction** Food vendors may sell food and snacks only, NO water and NO soft drinks. **Only the Ahwatukee Kiwanis Club sells water and soft drinks at the event.**

**Location** Ahwatukee Community Park, 4700 E Warner Rd

**Set Up** Vendors must provide their own setup and staffing. The Ahwatukee Kiwanis Club provides NO tents, chairs, tables, electricity, or staff to watch your booths. A limited number of pop ups are available to rent in advance for \$45. All food vendors are responsible for their own **health permit**. Vendors are solely responsible for the items in their space. Vendors in the parade should be set up and staffed before the parade. Others should be set up and ready by 10:30 am. **Set up starts at 8am.**

**Parking PLEASE ONE VEHICLE PER VENDOR!** We are subject to Phoenix Fire Department rules that limit parking on site, mandate space for emergency vehicles. Vendor parking is available for your driver named in the vendor's application on a first-come, first served basis. **No entry before 8 am.** A parking attendant checks in your driver and directs your driver where to park. There is NO UNLOADING LANE. Please unload from your parking space. Volunteers are available to help unload if you wish. Food trucks are parked with two wheels on the grass, so visitors walk on the grass up to your food truck. There is NO vendor parking allowed in the Community Center Parking Lot in front of the building until after 1pm. **Only emergency vehicles are allowed to drive on the grass.**

**Breakdown** We expect vendors to stay until 4pm. Vendors who depart early will be noted by volunteers for considering future applications.
